- Grass Taller than 9";
- Overgrowth that impedes onto the sidewalk or blocks traffic view;
- Inoperable unlicensed vehicles being stored on property;
- Vehicles parked on grass;
- Commercial vehicles stored in a residential zone:
- Recreational vehicles parked so that they project pass the front of the home;
- Trash or garbage containers left upon the sidewalk, the area between a street and sidewalk or the front yard, except for trash and garbage collection purposes;
- General maintenance: The exterior of a structure shall be maintained in good repair, structurally sound and sanitary so as not to pose a threat to the public health, safety or welfare;
- Unsecured vacant structures; and
- Outdoor storage of boxes, appliances, household items, tires or accumulation of trash.

 Department and a pool and fence requirement sheet must be signed by the homeowner

- Do Not blow grass clippings into the street to go into the storm drains;
- <u>Do Not</u> poor oils, gas or other liquids into the storm drains;
- In the fall, make sure you let your pool water sit until the chlorine dissipates before letting it get into the storm drains;
- Be a good neighbor, check the storm drains in your area. If they have trash or leaves in them clean it out or call the Drainage Department.

- Trash pickup must be out by 6:00 a.m.;
- Yard waste must be out by 6:00 a.m. (We DO NOT pick up yard waste in plastic bags because we take it to the compost center.);
- Yard waste can be in any trash can marked "Yard Waste", paper lawn and leaf bags, cardboard boxes or anything bio-degradable;
- Tree limbs are picked up by the Street Department. Stack them neatly to the curb with the
 cut ends facing the street. Visit their website at www.cityofjeff.net for a schedule of pick up
 dates for your area;
- Appliances and electronics (tv's computers, monitors, etc.) are picked up on Friday and you will need to call the Street Department to be on the list for this service;
- We DO NOT pick up tires (We are charged \$8.00 \$13.00 per tire at the landfill). We suggest you call a tire store to see if they take used tires.
- If you are remodeling or cleaning out a garage or rental property, you may want to consider renting a dumpster. If you have more than a pick-up truck load of debris there may be a charge; and
- We pick up latex paint ONLY IF IT IS DRIED UP (To dry up the paint, you can put kitty litter, sand or saw dust in the can and put the can beside your trash can with the lid off.
