- \* Entries are due in to the Mayor's Office by noon on Tuesday, Nov. 21, 2023 for consideration in the contest. The winning entry will be announced the first week of December. Only one grand prize winner will be selected. Entries deemed as finalists from each grade will be displayed in City Hall during the holiday season. All entries will be displayed on the video boards outside of the NOCO Arts Center in the Arts & Cultural District.
